Professional Learning Program for Community Language Teachers

The State Library of Western Australia houses an extensive Community Languages Collection with resources available for over 40 languages. The collection of language teaching materials and resources has been made available to language teachers, particularly those from the community languages sector, through the Office of Multicultural Interests.

These resources will assist teachers to develop teaching methodology, conduct language classes and develop language-teaching materials.

To understand the Community Language Collection, teachers can join Library staff for a single-session familiarisation course.
