



TERMS and CONDITIONS:
MLTAWA Competitions/Poster 2020

General

1. The promoter is: The Modern Language Teachers Association of WA Inc. <http://mltawa.asn.au/>
2. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter the competitions.
3. Route to entry for the competition/poster and details of how to enter are via the MLTAWA website <http://mltawa.asn.au/>
4. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.
5. It is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure that no copyright laws are violated while entering the competition/poster.
6. The promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition/poster and these terms and conditions without notice in the event of a catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, act of God or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of the promoter's control. Any changes to the competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by the promoter.
7. The promoter is not responsible for inaccurate prize details supplied to any entrant by any third party connected with this competition.
8. Winners will be chosen by specific judging panels for each individual competition.
9. Anyone connected to a submission, including teacher/student /parent relationships may not be permitted to take part in the judging process.
10. The winners will be notified by email.
11. The promoter will notify the winner (and in some cases the teacher and parent/guardian) by email, details about when and where the prize/certificates can be collected, during Term 3 for ♥ *Learning Languages Poster* and during Term 4 for *Family by My Side* and *Let Me Tell You a Story*.
12. The promoter will not be held responsible for unclaimed prizes or unsuccessful attempts to notify winners.
13. The promoter's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
14. By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
15. The competition and these terms and conditions will be governed by Australian law and any disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Australia.
16. Upon presentation of a prize/certificate at a MLTAWA event, the winner agrees to the use of his/her name and image in any publicity material. Any personal data relating to the winner or any other entrants will be used solely in accordance with current data protection legislation and will not be disclosed to a third party without the entrant's prior consent.
17. Any entrant agrees to the use of his/her name and image in any publicity material.
18. Subjects featuring in the Competitions/Poster who are under 18 must submit a signed Declaration Form and the Parent/Guardian Permission section must be signed by at least one parent/guardian.
19. The promoter has the right to withhold publication of student work if it is deemed that personal information conveyed could lead to ease of identification.
20. Winning students must be accompanied by a parent to attend a MLTAWA event to collect their prize.
21. Attendance at the MLTAWA event, including transport arrangements and liability in case of loss, theft or injury is the sole responsibility of the winner (if an adult) or the winner's parent/guardian (if a minor).

24. Entry into the competition will be deemed as acceptance of these terms and conditions.

♥ Learning Languages Poster

25. Submissions in the ♥ *Learning Languages* Poster are individual and not open to groups of students.
26. The closing date for the ♥ *Learning Languages* Poster is Friday, 3rd July 2020 and no late entries will be accepted.
27. Entry into the competition must be made via the Poster Submission Page on the MLTAWA website and must include a Declaration Form signed by student, parent/guardian and teacher (for each student).
28. There is no state judging of these entries. Teachers must judge the best poster from their school for each year level and scan to submit these. All submitted entries receive a merit certificate.
29. Teachers will be emailed their students' certificates by 24th July 2020 to present via a suitable school forum.

Family by My Side Competition

30. Submissions in the *Family by My Side* competition can only include second language learners at a school. If the judges deem a competitor to be a background or first language learner the submission will be withdrawn from judging.
31. The *Family by My Side* Competition is only open to students of members of the MLTAWA.
32. Entries in the *Family by My Side* Competitions are completed by students of the same family/a family group including adults in one of the family categories.
33. The closing date for the *Family by My Side* Competitions is Friday, 25th September 2020 and no late entries will be accepted.
34. Entry into the competition must be made via the Competition Submission Page on the MLTAWA website and must include a Declaration Form signed by student, parent/guardian and teacher (for each student/person under 18 years of age).
35. Teachers who have submitted entries or who are employees of schools whose students have submitted entries in the *Family by My Side* Competition may not be eligible to participate in the judging process.
36. Teachers, students and their parents of winning submissions will be notified via email and details of where and when to collect the prize will be provided by 12th October 2020.

Let me Tell you a Story Competition

37. Submissions of the *Let Me Tell You a Story* competition is for background or first language learners of any language. Second language learners can enter the *Family by My Side* Competition.
38. The *Let Me Tell You a Story* Competition is open to all background or first language students at a school in Western Australia.
39. Entries in the *Let Me Tell You a Story* Competition are completed by individuals. Entries from groups will not be accepted.
40. The closing date for the *Let Me Tell You a Story* Competition is Friday, 25th September 2020 and no late entries will be accepted.
41. Entry into the *Let Me Tell You a Story* competition must include a Declaration Form signed by each student and their parent/guardian.
42. Students and parents/guardians and teacher of winning submissions will be notified via email and details of where and when to collect the prize will be provided by 12th October 2020.
